



PROSPECTIVE SHOOTER PROCESS – SHOOTER ASSESSMENT FORM
Revision 1 – 15 December 2017

The purpose of this form is to assist the Safety Officer who will be responsible for the Prospective Shooter during the match to assess whether the Prospective Shooter will be able to compete in a match without endangering themselves, the Safety Officer, other shooters or members of the public. It also allows the Safety Officer to gauge the Prospective Shooters general awareness of safety, IDPA Rules and range etiquette, enabling the Safety Officer to focus on specific matters to advise the Prospective Shooter on during the course of the match
